3. GROUNDS OF APPEAL

GROUND ONE

THE LEARNED TRIAL JUDGE ERRED IN LAW WHEN HE DISCHARGED AND ACQUITTED THE DEFENDANTS AGAINST THE WEIGHT OF EVIDENCE ADDUCED AT THE TRIAL

PARTICULARS OF ERROR

- The trial Judge erred in law when he discharged and acquitted the defendants by assuming that the complainant withdrew the charge when in actual sense, both the parties agreed to compound the alleged offence.
- ii. The trial judge erred in law when he held as follows "it is my humble opinion complainant having agreed to invoke the provision of Section 48 of the Federal Inland Revenue Service Act at the stage which this case cannot be isolated from the provision of section 284 of the Criminal Procedure Act".

4. RELIEFS SOUGHT

- i. To allow the appeal.
- ii. To set aside the discharge and acquittal of the accused persons.


